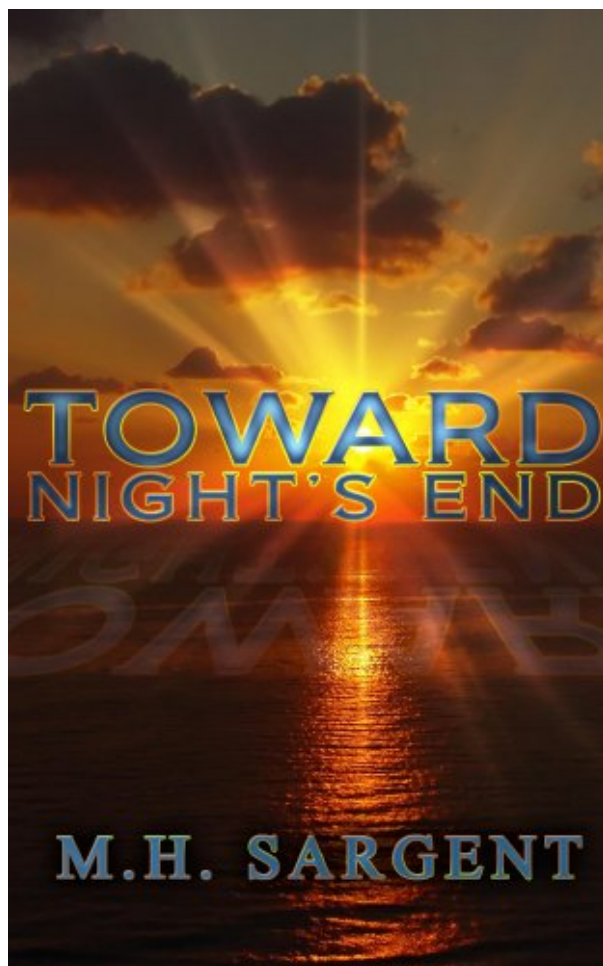
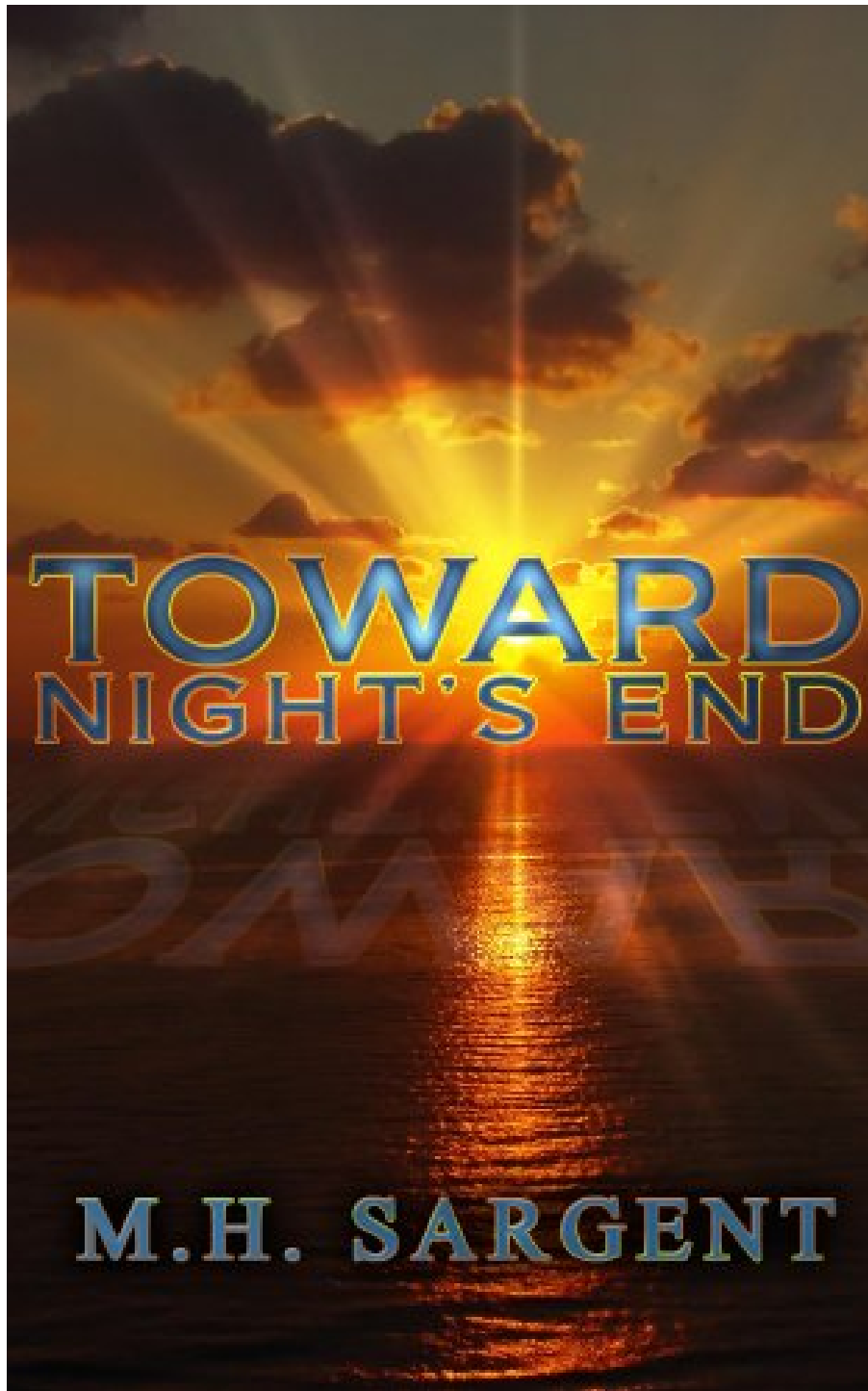

I have read all of the author's other books and enjoyed them. I have not yet finished *Toward Night's End*, but I will. It is quite apparent that the author failed to do any research. First, he refers to the truck's transmission being placed in 'Park' which would indicate an automatic transmission. Such were not found in trucks in 1942, but then he has the driver using the clutch. The author has an officer using a radio that was clipped to his belt which after use he returns to its holster. Radios in 1942 were simply not of a size that could be carried in a holster attached to a belt. He then has the officer take offense to the use of the term 'Jap' and insists that Matthew be referred to as a Japanese-American. The term was not generally used at the time. Later when Matthew is sick the captain of the boat he was on refused to let him have penicillin. This was in early 1942 when the entire production of penicillin would have treated a couple dozen people at most. The first country to allow the civilian population to have penicillin was Australia after WWII.

The author spins a good yarn, but does allow historic facts color his fiction.
